

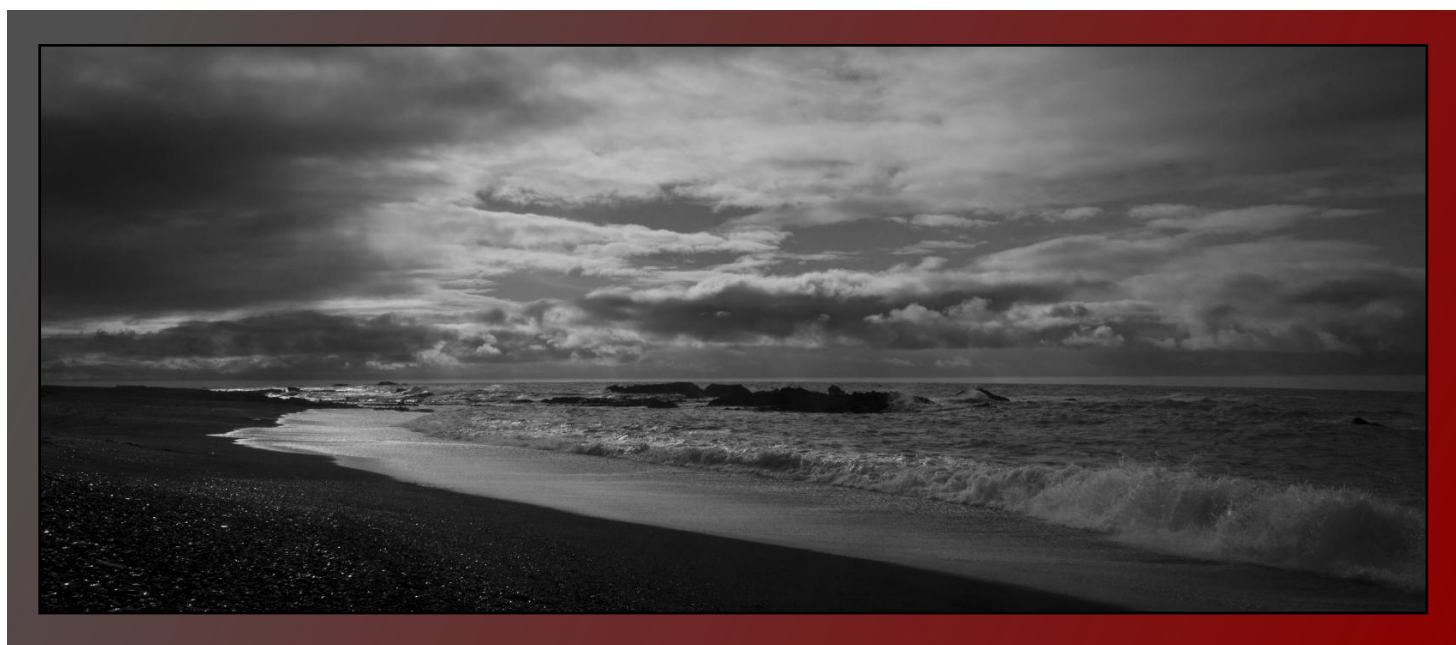


FIELD TRIP REPORT
